- 24 hour staff on-site, nursing care may be purchased, as required
- Private rooms and one bedroom suites with four-piece bathrooms
- Weekly housekeeping and laundry of bedding and towels
- All meals and snacks included
- Social and recreational activities included
- No smoking, cooking or pets
- Apply directly to the Home
- Cost is determined by Dom Lipa Retirement Home
- No government subsidies available

LONG-TERM CARE HOME

- Ethnic specific, 66 bed Slovenian Long-Term Care Home
- Residents must be medically stable but require ongoing care, may be cognitively impaired
- 24 hour assistance with personal care, eating, bathing, medications and medical/nursing needs
- Basic, semi-private and private accommodation
- Laundry and housekeeping
- Meals and snacks provided
- Social and recreational activities
- No smoking, cooking or pets
- Apply through LHIN, Local Health Integration Network
- Cost of accommodations shared with Government of Ontario; resident pays co-payment
- Standardized rates set by Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care, government subsidy available
